OVERVIEW OF THE PROGRAM

The Honor Council Program recognizes, annually, local and special interest councils that organize and conduct well-rounded programs serving the council members, the community, the state/provincial association, and the International Reading Association. The requirements for this award are to be completed between April 1 of one academic year and March 1 of the next.

PREREQUISITES

The completion of two prerequisites is necessary to determine whether a council is eligible to apply for Honor Council status. These two items are required of all councils to be in good standing according to IRA Bylaws.

P1 Submit the names and addresses of all officers of the council to the state/provincial coordinator. All officers must be members of the International Reading Association (IRA Bylaws, Article X, Section 3).

Action Complete and submit the "Report of Council Officers" for the coming council year by the deadline given on the form.

P2 Have at least 10 council members who are also members at the international level (IRA Bylaws, Article X, Section 4).

NOTE: The council officers for the year may be counted in this total.

Action Send a copy of the council's total membership to the state/provincial coordinator with the "Report of Council Officers." Include the IRA membership number with expiration date for each person who is an international member.

A council must be in good standing by October 15 of the program year to continue application for this program.

DEADLINES

The "**Intent to Participate**" form must be *postmarked no later than October 15*.

All documented data needed to complete Parts I-IV must be *postmarked no later than March 1*. However, councils are encouraged to submit the information to IRA Headquarters any time prior to the deadline. The earlier, the better.

Program Guidelines

Part I. Service to Local Council Members

Required Items

The following **three** items are required:

- Item 1** Increase local council membership (between April 1 and March 1) by the percentage indicated below. NOTE: This total includes all members of the council, not just international level members of the council.

Total Council Membership (April 1)	Percentage Increase Needed (March 1)
10–49	8%
50–149	4%
150+	2%

- Action** Have the state/provincial director of membership development verify that the council's membership has increased by the required percentage. Then send the verification to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*

NOTE: EXCEPTION: A council that has been an Honor Council for three years may choose to complete three of the Optional Items set forth under Part I of these guidelines (rather than the two stipulated), in lieu of the council membership percentage increase.

- Item 2** Provide a long range plan for your council. List the mission, goals, and activities projected for the next two to three years.

- Action** Send a copy of the long range plan to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*

- Item 3** Plan and carry out at least three council meetings during the council year. One of the meetings may be an inservice program or mini-conference.

- Action** Send a summary and timeline of programs and activities to be carried out by the council during the year to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*

Optional Items

Complete **two** of the following:

- Item 1** Produce and distribute to council members a newsletter or similar communication piece (print or electronic). Include news of local, state, and international activities.

- Action** Send a copy of the communication piece to IRA Headquarters. [No form needed.]

- Item 2** Develop a brochure, video, or website that includes the mission, activities, accomplishments, and a brief history of the council. Include information about local, state/provincial, and international membership.

- Item 3** Provide for the professional growth of students enrolled teacher preparation or related programs. Options include, but are not limited to, the purchase of IRA memberships for students, a council program or project that benefits students, or a scholarship for a student working toward a degree in education.
- Action** Send a description of the activity and financial guidelines, if applicable, to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 4** Implement a project to increase the professional growth of council members. Options include, but are not limited to, forming a Teachers as Readers group, providing a scholarship for a member pursuing an advanced degree in reading, sponsoring a seminar on a current issue, or providing indepth information for a specific topic on council website.
- Action** Send a description of the project and financial guidelines, if applicable, to IRA Headquarters. A form is enclosed.

Part II. Partnership with the Local Community

Complete **three** of the following:

- Item 1** Plan and implement a Celebrate Literacy program.
- Action** Using the Celebrate Literacy guidelines distributed to councils, carry out a Celebrate Literacy program. Send a summary of the program to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 2** Implement a project promoting literacy in the community served by the council. Examples include, but are not limited to, a reading day at the mall, a read-a-thon, a reading incentive program.
- Action** Organize and carry out the program. After its completion, submit a description and an evaluation of the activity to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 3** Participate in a Newspaper in Education project.
NOTE: The curriculum for a classroom newspaper project is available at Newspaper Association of America Foundation website www.naafoundation.org.
- Action** Plan and carry out activities to promote the use of the newspaper in the classroom. Submit a project summary to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 4** Develop and carry out a plan to advocate significant literacy issues. Examples include, but are not limited to, intellectual freedom/censorship, legislation, local education decision-making, early intervention, cultural awareness.
- Action** Organize and carry out the plan. After its completion, submit a summary and evaluation of the plan to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 5** Carry out a family reading or intergenerational family literacy project.
- Action** Organize and conduct the program. Send a summary to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 6** Sponsor or cosponsor an activity to encourage, support, and recognize young writers in the council area.
- Action** Plan and implement the activity. Submit a summary of the activity to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 7** Carry out a service project to benefit the community. Examples include, but are not limited to, reading to patients in nursing homes or to children in daycare centers, working with other community groups (Scouts, MADD, etc.), taping materials for the elderly or visually impaired, providing reading materials for homeless shelters, working with at-risk students, or promoting intergenerational and/or adult literacy.
- Action** Submit a summary of the service project to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
NOTE: Councils are also encouraged to submit this item as an entry for the IRA Local Council Community Service Award. Call 1-800-336-READ, ext. 236 for more information.

Part III. Partnership with State/Province and International Reading Association

Required Items

The following **two** items are required:

- Item 1** Carry out a membership campaign to increase membership at the local, state/provincial, and international levels.
NOTE: The campaign must promote all three levels of membership. Exceptions will be made when no state/provincial association exists.
- Action** Send a description of the membership campaign, stating objectives, procedures, and outcome of the campaign to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 2** Obtain the number of new international members indicated below.
NOTE: Any individual not currently an international member may be recruited as a new international member. **Council officers cannot be included in this item, but student memberships may be used.**

- Action** For each new member obtained between April 1 and March 1, write “Honor Council” and your council number on the membership application and send it immediately, with payment, to IRA Headquarters. Use the enclosed form to record information on these members and send it to IRA Headquarters with the last new member obtained.

Optional Items

- Item 1** Support the goals of the state/provincial association, if affiliated with IRA.
- Action** Describe three programs and projects that directly reflect the goals stated by the state/provincial association in its long range plan. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 2** Have a local council or board meeting attended by one of the following: a state/provincial officer, district or zone director, state/provincial coordinator, state/provincial board member, or state/provincial director of membership development.
- Action** Invite one of these individuals. Secure confirmation. Following the visit, have the individual submit a report verifying his or her attendance. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 3** Support the goals of the International Reading Association.
- Action** Describe three programs and projects that directly reflect the goals stated by the International Reading Association in its strategic plan. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 4** Provide a stipend that will assist a council member’s attendance at a convention, conference, leadership workshop or other event sponsored by the state/provincial association or the International Reading Association.
- Action** Send a description of the activity and verification of financial support with guidelines for selection of recipient to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 5** Obtain 5 new international members in addition to those in item 2 above.
- Action** For each new member under this item, write “Honor Council” and your council number on the membership application; send it to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
NOTE: Completion of this item, III-O5, and III-R2 qualifies a council for Membership Honor Roll.

Part IV. Partnership With the International Community

Complete **two** of the following:

- Item 1** Conduct or participate in an International Literacy Day celebration.
NOTE: Information on International Literacy Day can be obtained from IRA's website at http://www.reading.org/association/meetings/literacy_day.html.
- Action** Send a description of the International Literacy Day celebration to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 2** Sponsor an international membership for someone in an economically developing country. Use the Membership Project for Educators in Economically Developing Countries form provided in the council leaders packet.
- Action** Write "Honor Council" and your council number on the sponsored membership form(s) and send it immediately, with payment, to IRA Headquarters.
- Item 3** Contribute to worldwide relief efforts following a natural disaster by providing books, paper and pens, or funds to purchase needed items.
- Action** Send description and photocopy of documentation to IRA Headquarters verifying contributions. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 4** Carry out a project that will promote literacy outside your home continent. This project may involve a partnership with other agencies such as Peace Corps, Red Cross, International Book Bank, etc.
- Action** Contact a local agency in your area to see what projects are available that could use your assistance. Send a description of the project implemented to IRA Headquarters. *A form is enclosed.*
- Item 5** Develop a partnership with an IRA national affiliate or local council outside your home continent.
- Action** Send a description of partnership activities to IRA Headquarters. Activities may include correspondence between councils, shared newsletter articles, exchange programs, attendance of council member at a conference or other event sponsored by partner council, or joint literacy projects. *A form is enclosed.*
